

Students were shown the various stages of water treatment and how contaminants like dirt, chemicals, and harmful bacteria are removed, students were left with a detail idea on how much quantity of water is being treated, time taken for treatment of unclean water etc. The coordinators at the plant were very cooperative and provided valuable insights into the water treatment process. 



